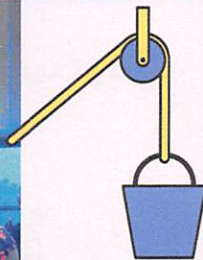

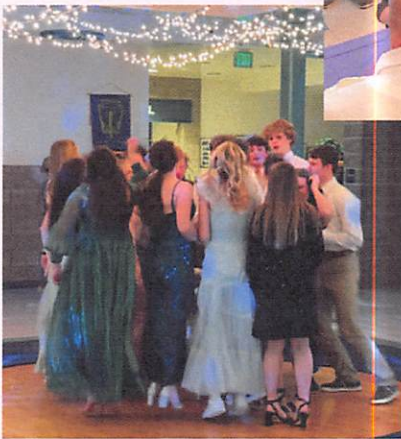

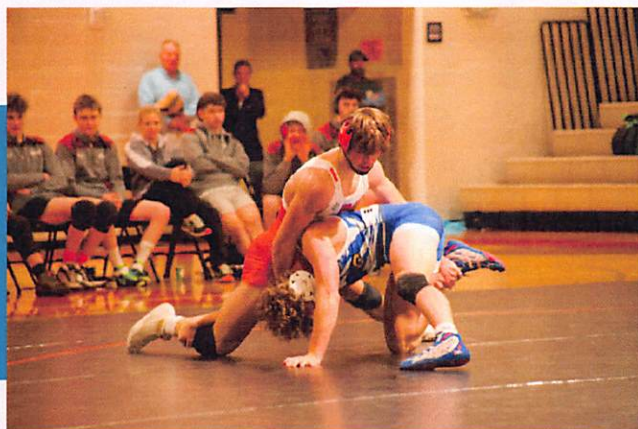

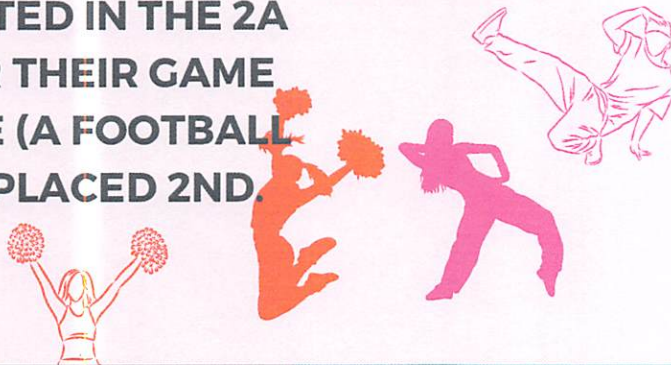


THEY PLACED 6TH IN THE 3A DIVISION OF HIP-HOP DANCE. THEIR ROUTINE WAS KILLER!
